# 2019 NZ Korean Study Tour Information

The Korean Education Centre (KEC) is pleased to announce the 2019 NZ Korean Study Tour (NZKST). The tour will consist of up to **15 participants (Principals/Deputy principals/Senior managements/Education administrators)**, and they will be travelling around Korea, visiting Korean schools and educational organizations between **13~20 April 2019**.

## Tour Objectives

- 1) To enhance the knowledge and understanding of South Korean contemporary culture, tradition and educational system
- 2) To build a network for supporting Korean language learning in local schools
- 3) To facilitate on/offline educational exchange between New Zealand and South Korea schools

## Eligibility

Qualified applicants need to meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 1) NZ primary/secondary schools' **principals/deputy principals/senior managements** *and*
- 2) Schools which have a high interest in taking Korean as a second language in the near future *or*
- 3) Schools which have already taken Korean as a second language *or*
- 4) Schools which are interested in organizing an educational excursion to Korea in the near future
- 5) Education administrators (Ministry of Education, NZQA, CAPE, ILEP, TPLT, Asia NZ Foundation and more)

## Costs

- Participation fee: **NZD 1,200.00** (Full amount must be paid by **Fri, 15 February 2019**)
- Deposit fee (Successful applicants only): **NZD 300.00** by **Fri, 7 December 2018**
- Inclusions: Return air flight ticket (Airplane schedules cannot be changed), taxes, Accommodation, meals, all land tour arrangements and entry fees
- Exclusions: Passport issuance, travel insurance, personal expenditures, telecommunications, own travel to Auckland airport

## Responsibility

After taking part in the trip, successful participants are expected to share experience and knowledge about Korea to wider communities. (School newsletter, BOT meeting, School assembly, Local newspapers and Education Gazette etc.)

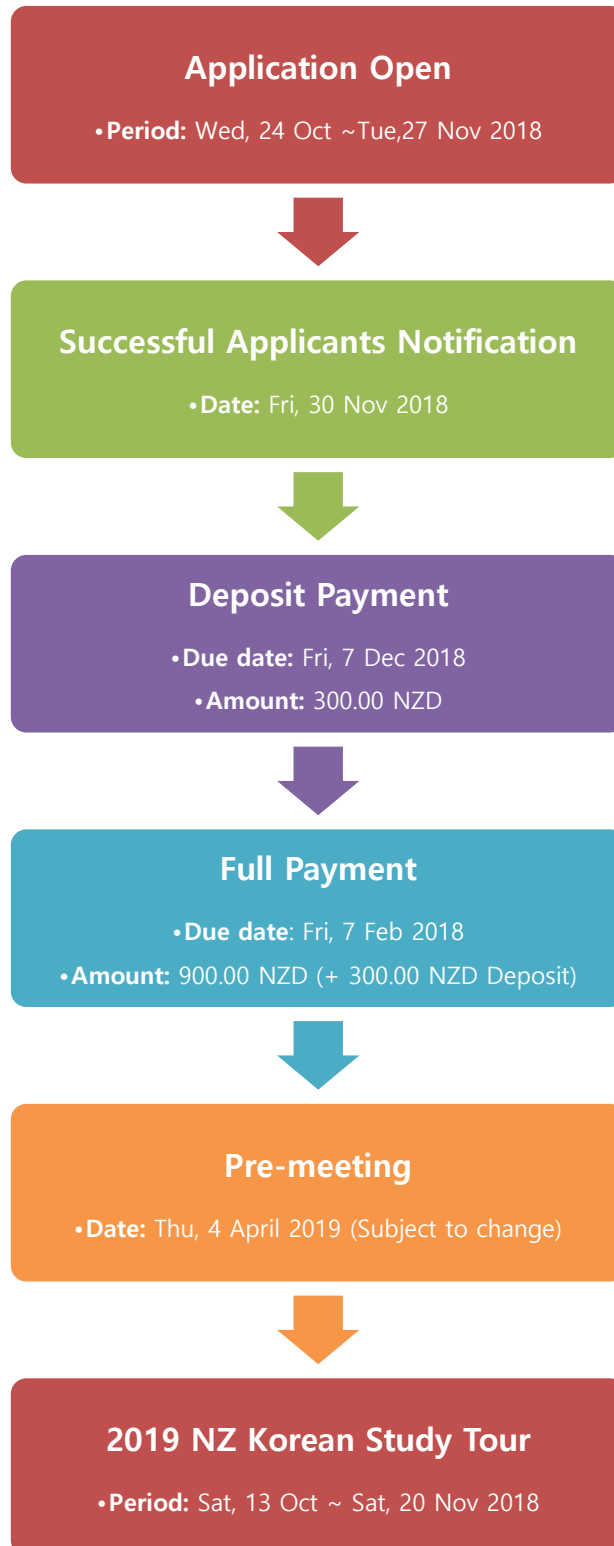
