Tāmaki Makaurau Education

What has happened so far and what we have learnt...

- What are iwi saying: (Manawhenua and Mātāwaka/Taurahere)
 - The Mana Motuhake/Autonomy remains with each of the iwi
 - No compromise to existing accords, relations with agencies eg MOE, TEC, etc
 - Clarity of Role & Responsibility of Manawhenua, and Taurahere/Raawaho
 - Collaborative action
 - Platform to share ideas & practise
 - Mātauranga Māori
 - Te Reo Māori revitalisation reo ā iwi, reo ā hapū
